Adventure Club night is an exciting and busy time for clubbers and leaders. Of course, we want this to be both fun and safe for everyone so please help with the following:

- Hoppers (ages 2, 3) should be dropped off in their classroom (room 3, downstairs). When club is
  over for the evening, Hoppers are also picked up in room 3. Please do not send siblings younger
  than junior high to pick up Hoppers. Please LET THE CLUB SECRETARY KNOW IF SOMEONE OTHER THAN
  YOU WILL BE PICKING UP YOUR CHILD.
- 2. **Trackers, Scouts and Trailblazers** (age 3 to grade 6) are checked in on arrival by the club secretary in the foyer of the sanctuary. When club is over for the evening please sign out your clubber(s) with the Club Secretary by signing your initials in the box next to their picture. For their safety, we do not allow clubbers to exit the sanctuary until their parent or guardian has signed them out. **Please Let the club secretary know if someone other than you will be picking up your CHILD.**
- 3. **Youth Leaders** do not have a sign in/out. They are considered leaders-in training (LIT) and are encouraged to help with re-setting the sanctuary when their respective club times are over.

#### 4. All clubs:

- Please be prompt in picking up your clubber(s) at the end of club night.
- Once you have signed out your children please have them play and fellowship outside. It slows
  down the check-out process for other clubbers when those already checked out are coming back
  in. It takes considerable effort to return the sanctuary to its Sunday morning set up and it would
  be helpful to the people setting rows of chairs if children were playing outside at that time.
- Outside of game time, children should not be running in the sanctuary
- Please keep all children from climbing on chairs at all times.

As always, we want to thank you for allowing us to serve your children. We will do everything we can to keep a healthy environment for everyone. We ask for you to help by complying with a few health guidelines.

Your child should not be in any Adventure Club activity with other's children if they have, but not limited to, any of the following symptoms:

- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Sore Throat
- Any symptom that would normally keep a child home from school or church
- · Unusually lethargic behavior
- Vomiting or Diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- An unidentified rash or uncovered wet wounds
- Contagious conditions such as head lice, pinworms, pinkeye, impetigo, etc.
- Positive test for COVID19 within the last 14 days or Influenza within the last 7 days.

Adventure Club staff is not permitted to administer any medication (over-the-counter or prescribed) to your children. If this presents an issue for your child, please let us know so we can arrange an appropriate time for you to treat them. We would ask that you not leave any medications in the classroom, with your child, or in your child's bag. The only exception to this is that you may leave asthma-related rescue inhalers (properly labeled) with children who regularly self-treat at home/school. Please notify the Adventure Club secretary and their Adventure Club leader that you have done so.

Adventure Club leaders reserve the right to ask you to retrieve your child if they are acting ill or unable to participate due to illness.
